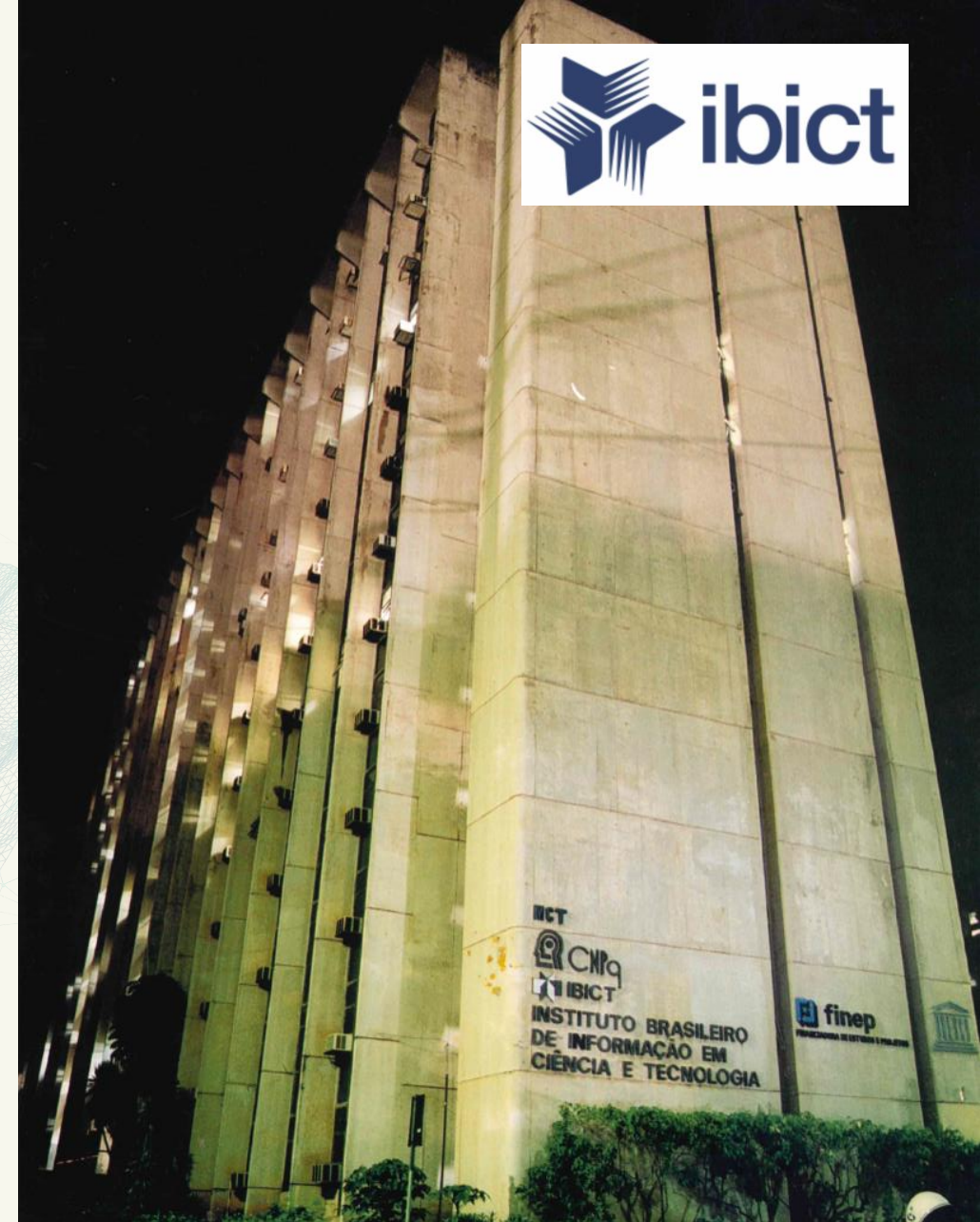

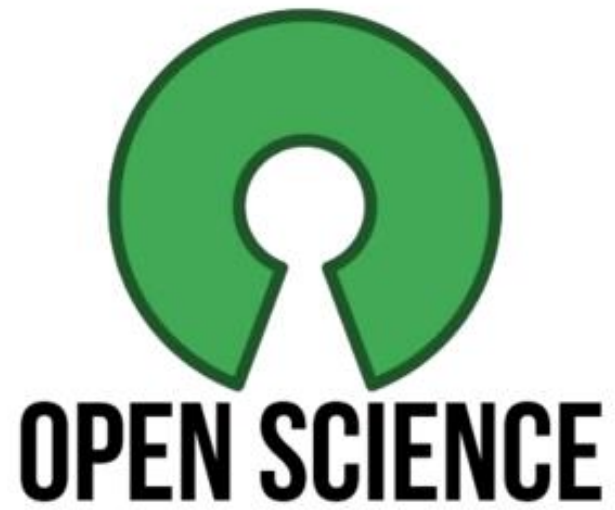


Anvisa continues its inspection measures and is working to remove advertisements from the internet that advertise the product chlorine dioxide, also sold under the acronym MMS. The reason is the claim of therapeutic properties for a chemical substance that has no proof of safety for use in humans. Since June 2018, the Agency has prohibited the manufacture, distribution, marketing and use of these products.

The use of chlorine dioxide has been touted as a "miracle" cure for a variety of diseases, including autism. The product is actually a substance used in the formulation of cleaning products, such as bleach and water treatment.

Chlorine dioxide is not approved as a medicine anywhere in the world. Its ingestion poses immediate and long-term risks to patients, especially children.

On April 25, the Agency had already requested that the Mercado Livre *website* remove two advertisements from the air. The advertisements indicated use for autism treatment and offered protocols for using the product to its buyers. Other advertisements were to be removed from the air the following day, April 26.

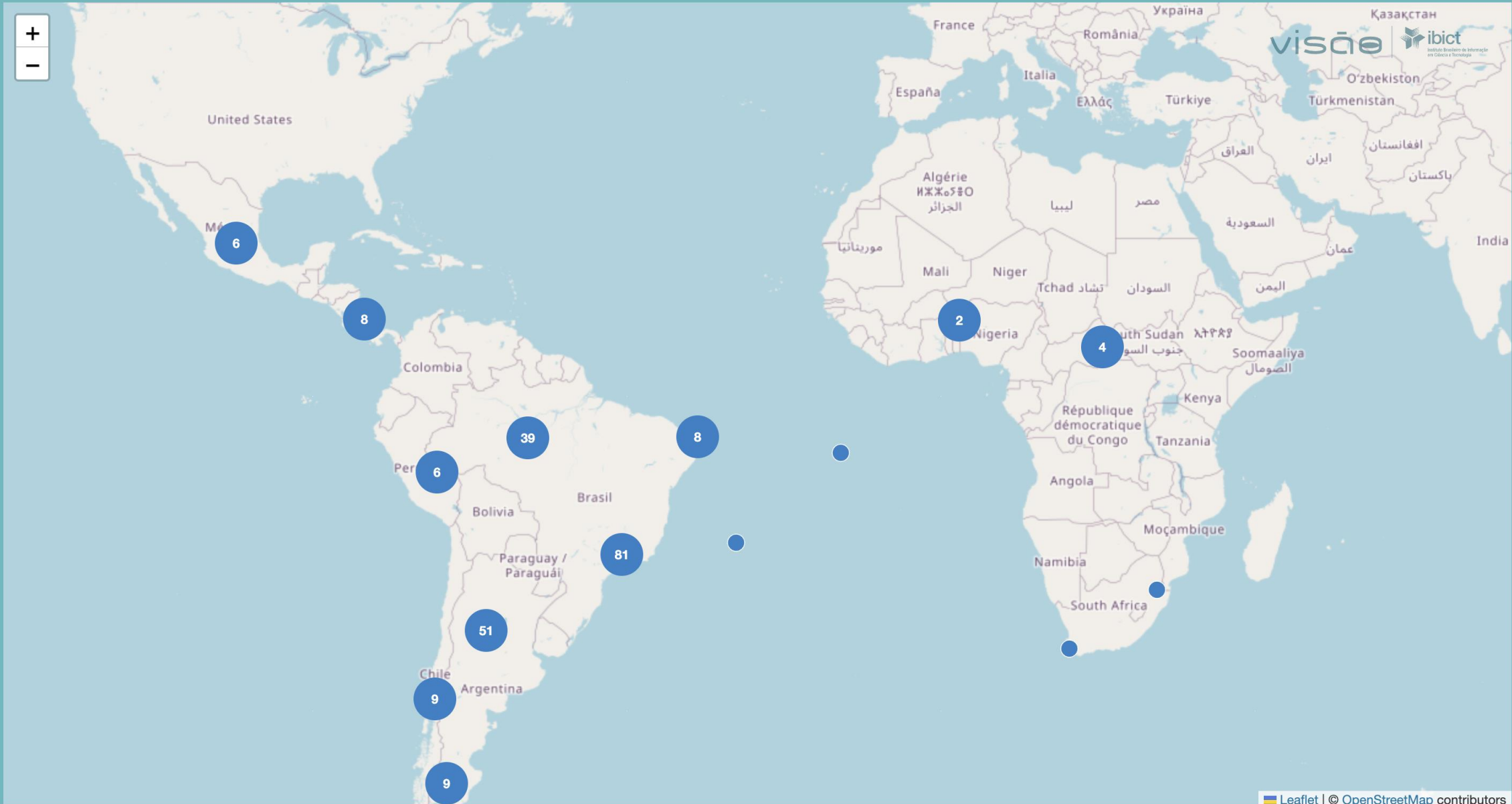
What is Civil?

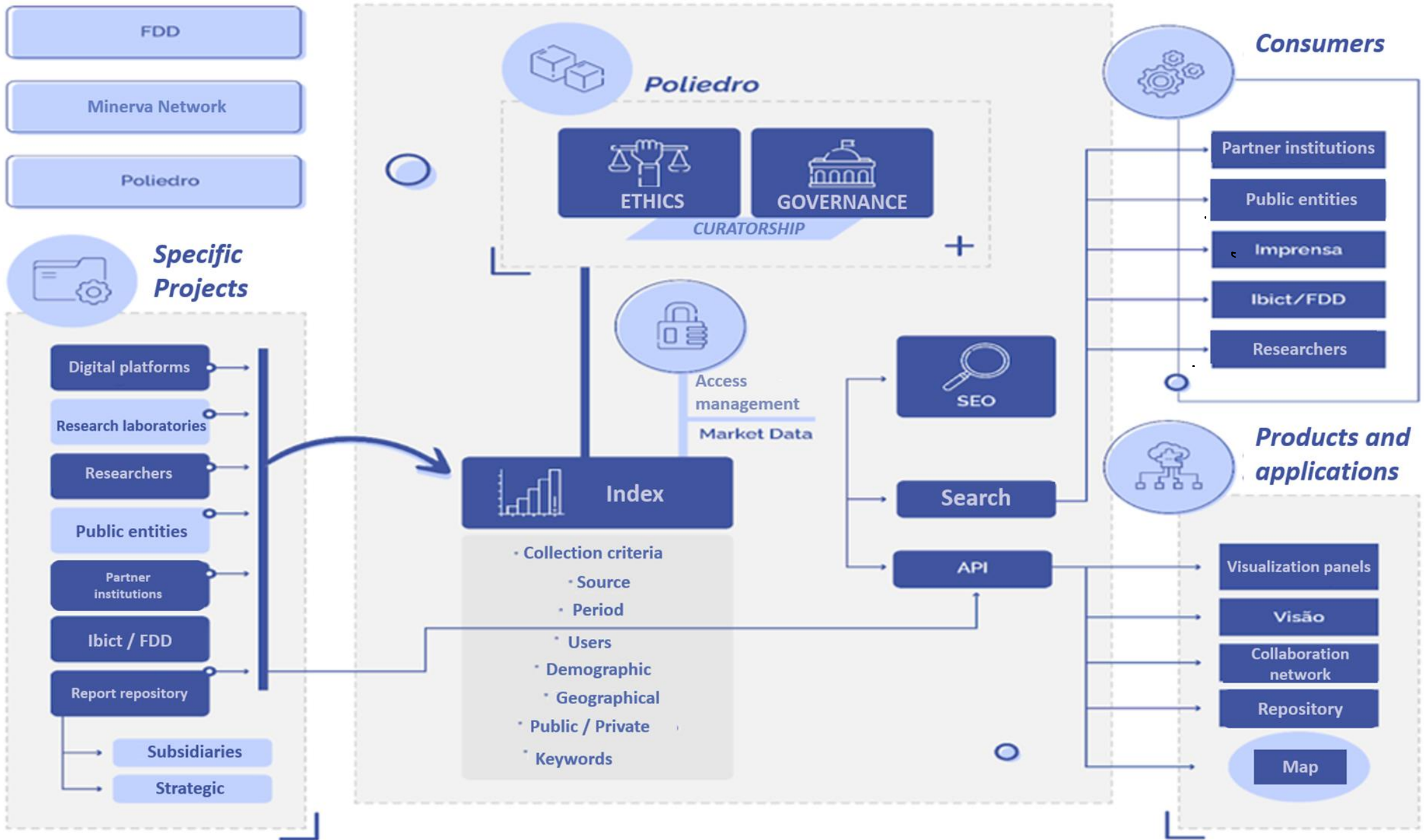




Research Network for the Promotion of Information Integrity
